Yarra Greens Policies September, 2020

We believe that everyone has a right to, and a responsibility to work towards, a clean environment. How we deal with waste impacts on the environment, the climate, and on our standard of living. We support creating a circular economy as distinct from a linear waste system, which leads to landfill.

In collaboration with Yarra residents, the State Government and other Councils, we aim to reduce, re-use, recycle and repair by utilising the best waste, recycling and sustainability solutions.

We commit to:

Zero waste to landfill by 2030

- · Implement the four-bin waste system across Yarra, including a local organic waste system that draws on best practice and new technologies.
- Plan for, monitor and review the Victorian container deposit scheme as it is rolled out to ensure accessibility, community input, household and visitor education and that it functions properly.
- Work with and lobby State Government to establish means of incorporating soft plastics as part of the fourbin waste system.
- Review and expand the range of waste fleet vehicles to meet the broad range of municipal waste collection needs.

- Transition Yarra's waste management fleet to zeroemissions electric vehicles.
- Work with and lobby State and Federal Governments to establish use of standardised materials that can more readily be reused or recycled as part of a circular economy.
- Improve the hard waste system to increase recycling rates.

At Work and at Home

- Promote home-based organic compost systems that complement the four-bin waste system.
- Require new developments to include composting and recycling facilities that complement the four-bin waste system.
- Advocate to State Government to improve recycling facilities in Yarra's multi-level public housing with recycling bins on every floor.
- Transition private waste collection to councilrun collection at large residential and commercial properties.

Council working with Business

- Further encourage traders to remove plastic packaging with the aim of becoming a plastic packaging free municipality.
- Continue to implement Council's policy on single use plastics in Council facilities, to move towards a ban on the provision of plastic bottles at Council venues.
- Encourage, promote and support existing and new repair cafés in Yarra.

Community participation

- Improve communications from Council that promote and educate community members on ways to reduce, re-use, repair and recycle at home, at work and via Council services.
- Support campaigns to remove plastic litter from land environments and in waterways including active support for the Yarra Riverkeeper campaign, and Friends of Merri Creek.
