Principles

The Australian Greens believe that:

- 1. The invasion of Timor-Leste in 1975 led to decades of human rights abuses and enormous suffering by the Timorese people.
- 2. Australia shares responsibility for this tragedy through its active and passive support for the invasion and occupation of Timor-Leste.
- 3. Australia must act as a supportive neighbour and help the Timorese maintain a thriving and democratic nation.

Goals

The Australian Greens will work for:

- 4. Strong aid support to enable Timor-Leste to achieve its development goals as rapidly and sustainably as possible.
- 5. Fair dealing with Timor-Leste in any negotiations around maritime boundaries.
- 6. The Timorese People to equitably share in all the benefits accruing from the development of natural resources belonging to the nation.
- 7. Good corporate citizenship by Australian companies doing business in Timor-Leste.
